Eta Kappa Nu (HKN) is the national honor society for Electrical and Computer Engineering (ECE). HKN was founded in 1904 at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.

HKN has over 200 chapters in the United States, Europe, and Asia. Eligibility depends on scholarship, personal character, voluntary services, and distinguished accomplishments. Membership is extended to graduates and undergraduates in the top fraction of their class.

HKN forms the link between the ECE students, faculty, and industry. Over the years, HKN has helped many companies become prospective targets for some of the nation's top engineering graduates.

The Beta Mu Chapter of HKN at Georgia Tech has an active membership of over 180 students and has received the Outstanding Chapter Award for 6 consecutive years!

## Who we are

Eta Kappa Nu, HKN for short, is a nonprofit organization that seeks to recognize outstanding students in the fields of electrical and computer engineering (ECE). The Beta Mu chapter was established at Georgia Tech in 1941 and has won the Outstanding Chapter Award each of the past six years, a considerable achievement given that the award is only given to only a handful of HKN's 200 chapters each year. We require a 3.5GPA or graduate status for induction, so our organization is made up of only the highest caliber students. Our chapter currently has over 200 members at GT.



## What we do

Our organization is one of the most active on campus and we provide a variety of valuable services to the ECE department.

- We regularly host information sessions on behalf of corporations, graduate schools, or scholarship opportunities.
- We host the Graduate Research Opportunities Workshop each year, helping graduate students to network with professors to learn about research opportunities.
- Our most visible activity is the Lab Chip Packaging Project. We purchase, package, and sell kits for the four primary lab classes offered by the ECE department. We have used the profits from the LCPP to permanently endow a scholarship that is awarded to an ECE junior every semester.

## Benefit Descriptions

**Bridge 2 Business:** B2B meetings allow a company to come and present to interested students. These are a great way to network with and recruit ECE students. We furnish publicity and refreshments for these events.

**Resume Book:** Every semester we compile a book of members' resumes to companies for recruiting purposes. Initiation into our organization requires a 3.5GPA, so this book represents the very best our department has to offer.

**Logo on Lab Supplies:** Every semester, we sell 400 parts kits as part of our Lab Chip Packaging Project. These kits are used by ECE students in virtually every upper-class semester. Our sponsors' logos are included on each kit, providing a means to introduce your company to students.
