Eta Kappa Nu (HKN) is an Electrical and Computer Engineering honor society dedicated to the recognition of scholars who by their attainments in college or practice, have manifested a deep interest and marked ability in the profession of Electrical and Computer Engineering.

Organization: Eta Kappa Nu (HKN) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit association. Georgia Tech's HKN chapter (Beta Mu) was chartered in 1941. HKN has about 180,000 members and over 200 active chapters in top universities worldwide.

Membership: Eligibility requirements for juniors are a minimum GPA of 3.5 and for seniors a GPA of 3.4. New initiates are inducted from the academically most successful ECE students each semester.

Opportunities: HKN offers its members leadership opportunities, professional and academic development, community service outreach programs, scholarships.

Programs: Our activities on the Georgia Tech campus include the HKN initiation banquet, ECE Student Project exhibit, ECE Spring Picnic, our highly successful lab chip supplies project, the Outstanding Student Scholarships, and the Outstanding Professor Awards.

Activities: The HKN Chapter at Georgia Tech is actively involved on and off campus with our programs. In addition to that we plan and host social events, PhD prelim exam information sessions, Graduate Fellowship information sessions, MBA information sessions, undergraduate research information sessions etc. All these activities are geared towards broadening the horizons of the brightest ECE students.

Philanthropic: Because HKN is a (c)(3) organization, funding is tax deductible.

Corporate Support: HKN's membership consists of the best and brightest students in ECE. Through involvement with HKN our sponsors can create a strong positive image with the top students among those who will be entering the job market within one or two years. HKN events are also great recruiting opportunities, where company representatives can interact with students in an informal setting or simply collect resumes. 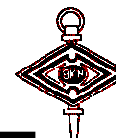

ECE Spring Picnic: The Spring picnic is a hugely popular event that may have up to 2400 students and faculty attending. Sponsors get visibility with logos, flyers and address all of ECE at Georgia Tech. (\$3000)

Bridge to Business: Corporate representatives make presentations and break out for informal discussions with students over Pizza and drinks. (\$500)

Chip Supplies Project: HKN's chip supplies project sells lab kits for ECE lab classes to students cheaper than competing bookstores. HKN members package parts bought in bulk quantities to make cheaper kits possible, saving Georgia Tech students money. Sponsorship of this well known project, grants our sponsors visibility to all of ECE. (Any contributions welcome)

Outstanding Junior Award: Awarded each semester to the best Junior year student at HKN's initiation banquet. The sponsor's name is associated to the award.(\$500)
